The bush vine Grenache – planted 1951

Vineyard

100% HUGO Estate grown Grenache – From a 4 acre bush vine Grenache block planted in 1951 (66 years old).

The best section was selected and handpicked on 9th March 2017 with Hugo Family personally screening bunches as buckets are put into bin.



Winemaking

Once handpicked bunches were then left in Bin for Whole bunch fermentation, to create a perfumed, juicy style wine.

Aging old French oak hogsheads for 7 months before bottling.

Total Production – 108 Dozen

Tasting notes

Colour

Clear, deep marron with hints of violet.

Bouquet

Fruit scents of bright red cherry, pomegranate and rose petal.

Palate

Volumes of clean fresh vibrant and juicy red berry fruit flavours of cherry, strawberry and raspberry, with delicate spice and Turkish delight flavours, complimented by fine silky tannins and a wonderful soft vibrant finish.
