## HUGO Sauvignon Blanc 2023

*Single vineyard Sauvignon Blanc from an established vineyard in Mount Torrens. This wine is fresh and crisp with tropical and citrus characters yet also showing layers of complexity with weight and texture.*

**Tasting Note** Tropical flavours following through on the palate to include passionfruit, citrus lemon & lime and finish with a refreshing acidity

**Vintage** One of the more challenging years in the past decade. Rain from September - through to harvest created consistent challenges in reaching optimal ripeness. Thankfully attention to detail in viticulture including bunch thinning to reduce crop load & speed up ripening, lift up foliage wires to let in more sun light, and restricted irrigation provided some outstanding results particularly in the younger grenache block.

**Vineyard** Single vineyard Sauvignon Blanc from an established vineyard in Mount Torrens.

**Winemaking** Fruit was picked in the cool hours of the night and crushed early morning. Fermented cool to preserve fruit purity and delicacy. Bottled middle of May to capture citrus characters and wine's natural freshness.

**Serve** Crispy skinned salmon with a fennel, orange and walnut salad, crème fraîche or yoghurt.
